

## **Explanation of GRAL Top 50 Report**

The GRAL Top 50 Report is updated each week to show the Fastest 50 GRAL Swimmers in each Event.

Please note that some GRAL teams have pools that are 25 YARDS in length, while others have pools that are 25 METERS in length. This report (and others on this site) first convert times swam in a 25 Yard pool to an equivalent Meters time. The general rule for converting a Yard time to a Meters time is that the Yard time is multiplied by 1.11. The general rule for converting a Meter time to a Yard time is that the Meter time is multiplied by 0.90.

Additionally, on some reports you may see a "Y" next to a swimmer's time. This "Y" indicates that the time represents a Yards time. If you see a "S" next to a swimmer's time, this "S" (Short Course Meters), this time represents a Meters time.

All printed Meet results include either "25 Yard" or "25 Meter" in the Event Description. Additionally, the pool length can be found for each pool on this website, via About Us, Teams by Division, then selecting the Division in question. The description for each team includes their pool configuration, approximate number of swimmers on their team, and a link to the team's website.
